in Scholarships and Mentoring Program Assistance in FY22 and \$69k in scholarships, mentoring, and job training since 2017.



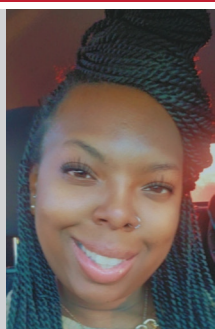
As students returned to traditional classrooms post-pandemic, TSLF continued to offer scholarships to TCC and UT Arlington students.
